

Janusz Korczak

Who was he?

His pen name was Hersz Goldszmit. He was also known as Old Doctor and Mister Doctor. Although he was born in a Jewish family, he became in later life an agnostic, who did not believe in forcing relgion on children. He worked as a tutor after school, he studied medicine and finally become a pediatrician. In the meantime he wrote some books under a pseudonym - Janusz Korczak.

Who else was he?

- a man who fought for childrens' rights in all his spheres of activity;

People were always limited with regard to their freedom and sense of equality between the races, genders and levels of a lifestyle. Firstly slaves and serfs had no rights to freedom. Then women suffer similar problem, but mostly about none chance to educate and to decide about themselves. The Woman Liberation Movement tried to establish equal rights and privileges for men and women. In this context, only children haven't been set free. That was Janusz Korczak's idea to help them fight for their provileges. Janusz Korczak was the one of advocates, spokesmen and real protectors of children's rights. Moreover, he was one of the first preachers of the idea "the child is an autonomous person, who has his own dignity, interests, needs and rights". According to his words "It is not that a child will become a human being, he is one already." he truly believed that children were fully fledged human beings. He also wanted the children to be treated and respected as they deserve to. Korczak

believed that children should be treated as their parents' partners, not as their own property. What is more, he came up with three basic rights:

- 1. The right of a child to his/her own death.
- 2. The right of a child to the present day.
- 3. The right of a child to be what he/she is.
- a man who wanted to divide his wisdom about childrens' world and to improve the bonds between adults and children; he presented them in a total of 24 his books;

an example:

- a writer who had an unique bond with children - thanks to this he wrote a lot of childrens' novels; some of his novels were translated into 20 languages;
